



## General Advising Notes for Science and Math

- Biology Majors are required to take 4 semesters of Chemistry so they need to start with CHEM 1211 the first semester.
- Chemistry Majors also have to take 4 semesters of Chemistry so they need to start with CHEM 1211 the first semester.
- Pre-Engineering majors need to take the Calculus based Physics (PHYS 2211/2212)
- Pre-Engineering majors should take the CHEM 1211/1212 sequence if they plan on going to Georgia Tech.
- If a student does not need MATH 1113 as part of their major, then they should be taking MATH 1001 instead of MATH 1111.
- Students who make below a "C" in College Algebra are advised not to take MATH 1113 until they have passed with a higher grade.
- ISCI 2001/2002 and MATH 2008 are for education majors only.
- ISCI 2001 and 2002 are only offered once a year. ISCI 2002 in the fall and ISCI 2001 in the spring. Both classes are hands-on activity based so we will not offer them as an independent study. Make sure the students sign up for these classes when they are offered or they might not be able to graduate.
- PHYS 1111/2211 and CHEM 2240 are only offered in the fall.
- PHYS 1112/2212 and CHEM 2241 are only offered in the spring.
- Students should take their math classes as soon as possible (in case they need to retake it.)
- Area D is for general science classes so only one upper level science (i.e. A&P I or II) can be used in this area.
- At least one area "D" class must include a lab.
