3-Year Graduation Rate of Student-Athletes

In accordance with the Student Right to Know and Campus Security Act of 1990 (also known as the Clery Act), South Georgia State College provides the following information on graduation rates of the **Fall 2020 cohort of Full-Time, First-Time (FTFT), associate degree-seeking student-athletes.**

Please note that all graduation rates apply to first-time, full-time, undergraduate degree-seeking students and are based on up to 3 years of associate degree program enrollment, equating to 150% of the normal completion time. Graduation rates do not include students who left school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions, with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were disabled.
