Residents should have paid all college fees prior to moving in. Requests to move in at times other than those listed require the Resident Manager's approval. All freshmen or new campus residents are required to attend orientation. If you have questions about your admissions status, please contact the Office of Enrollment Services and Student Success. If you have any questions regarding your financial status, please contact the SGC Business Office. Every effort will be made to honor applicants' requests for suite preference; however, no guarantees are made that students will receive their first choice.

Suite Rates: 2 Bedroom, one bath semi-suite: \$2,125 estimated per semester
4 Bedroom, two bath suite: \$2,125 estimated per semester

Meal Plans: 10 meals per week: \$1,300 estimated (\$200 of this may be used at the Center Court Café & partnering locations)
14 meals per week: \$1,600 estimated (\$200 of this may be used at the Center Court Café & partnering locations)
16 meals per week: \$1,675 estimated (\$200 of this may be used at the Center Court Café & partnering locations)
The Residence Life staff recommends the 14 or 16 meals per week. 10 meal plans can be used only for 2 meals per day, Monday through Friday.

Cafeteria: Monday – Thursday: breakfast, lunch, dinner
Friday: breakfast, lunch
Saturday – Sunday: brunch

Cable Television: This is included in contract rate. We receive approximately 60 channels. **Telephone Service:** Phone jacks are provided in each room. You may make arrangements with the local provider for telephone service.

Internet Service: Internet access is provided through Charter Communications. It is included in the contract rate. Wireless cards may be required for PCs. Computer cables are necessary in Tiger Village.

Residence Hall Information:

- The residence halls are smoke-free buildings. Smoking is not allowed in any areas of the residence halls.
- Laundry rooms are located on the first floor.
- No pets are allowed except fish.
- Candles and incense are not allowed.
- Students are responsible for securing items and locking doors. **Renters' insurance is recommended.**
- Appliances allowed in rooms: television, radio, small refrigerator, small microwave. (size & wattage restrictions apply)
- Appliances NOT allowed in rooms: hot plate, electric grill, and similar items. This rule complies with state fire codes.
- Arrangements must be made with the Resident Manager to store personal belongings between contract periods.
- Visitation rules are outlined in the *Residence Hall Handbook*, which can be found at website listed below.
- Rooms are not carpeted. Students may bring area rugs and curtains (blinds provided). Shower curtains, linens, towels, washcloths and bathroom products, including tissue, are not provided.
- Each bedroom has 1 bed, 1 desk and 1 chair. Mattresses are 36" by 82" by 7".
- Residence halls will be closed for announced breaks.

Student Health Insurance & Health Fee: All students are encouraged to carry health and accident insurance. International students are required to secure insurance through the U S G Student Health Insurance Program, or show proof of comparable coverage. There is no infirmary on campus, however, campus residents are assessed a \$35 health fee each term which entitles them to 2 visits per semester to the CRMC Walk-in-Clinic. Room Dimensions: All ceilings in the living areas are 9'. Room measurements: Bedrooms in 2BR semi-suites: 10' 4" x 11'5". Bedroom in 4 BR suites: 7' 9" x 9' 4", with living area of 10'3" x 20' 4". The rooms have Venetian blinds, so no window treatments are required. Tiger Village features 3 floors, with elevator access.
