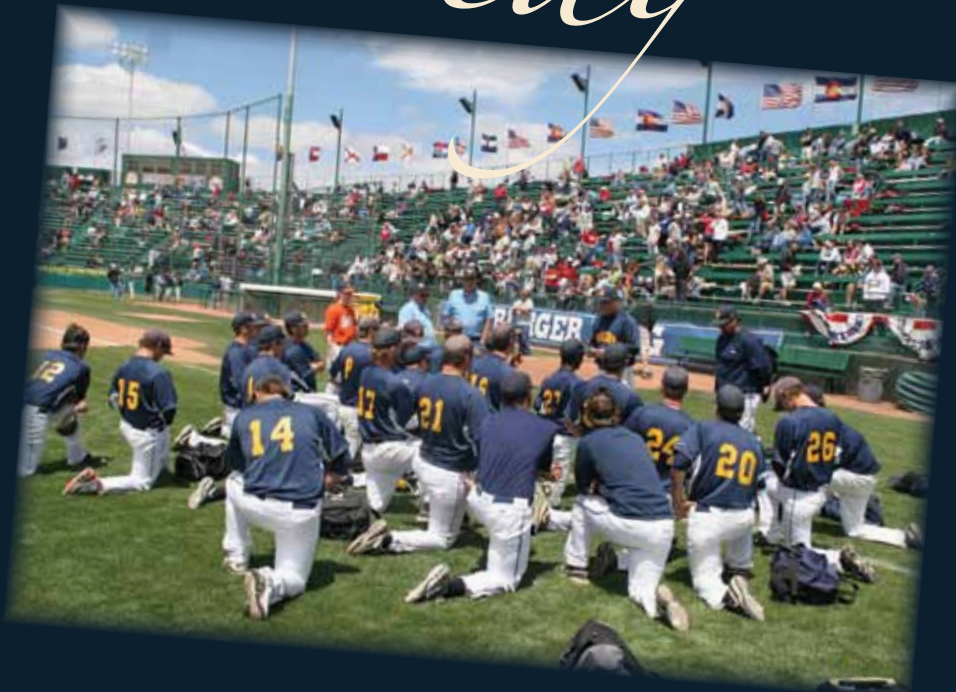

Get Started... Admissions

At South Georgia College, we want your enrollment experience to be effortless. Here are six simple steps to get started:

- 1 First, submit your enrollment application and the \$20 fee.
- 2 Submit official copies of high school transcripts or GED scores.
- 3 Submit your immunization form completed by a healthcare professional.
- 4 Take the COMPASS entrance tests. SAT or ACT scores may substitute but are not required.
- 5 Submit official transcripts from any college(s) attended.
- 6 Please complete a FAFSA application to determine if you are eligible for financial aid or scholarships. Remember to check submission deadlines.

Enrollment service staff members are always willing to help make your transition to South Georgia College an easy one. We will provide any forms or documents that you may need and also help answer any questions about SGC both before and after you arrive on campus.

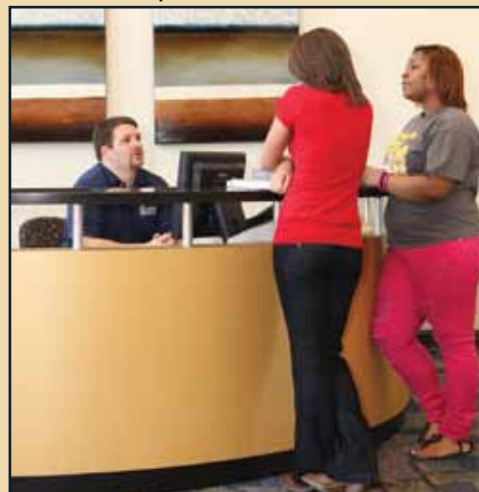

Get Help... Financial Aid

South Georgia College provides financial aid services for students in the form of grants, loans, scholarships and part-time employment. Students who wish to be considered for financial aid should apply early and make regular inquiries to ensure that all necessary paperwork has been received by submission deadlines.

Students may apply for financial aid online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. For HOPE-eligible students, the FAFSA may also serve as the application for the HOPE Scholarship or the student can complete a GSFAPPS at www.gacollege411.org.

Federal work-study opportunities are available for qualified students.

Associate of Science in Nursing

The Division of Nursing at SGC is fully approved by the Georgia Board of Nursing and is accredited by the National League for Nursing Accrediting Commission. Graduation from the SGC Division of Nursing, or the satellite nursing program at Waycross College, allows students to apply for the National Council Licensure Examination-Registered Nurse (NCLEX-RN), a required exam for nursing students applying for their registered nurse license. Nursing students from South Georgia College consistently surpass national and state pass rate averages on the NCLEX-RN. SGC's nursing program also provides advanced program placement for qualified LPNs. For more information, call 912.260.4358.

SGC Entry Programs

South Georgia College has partnered with Valdosta State University (VSU) and Georgia Southwestern State University (GSW) to offer Entry Programs on their campuses. The SGC Entry Program (SGCEP) provides students with a smooth transition from high school to the university setting. SGCEP students also have access to all the academic resources and extracurricular activities available to students at VSU and GSW.
