- Be a graduate of Coffee High School
- Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0

### QUIDA ALEXANDER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0

### AMERICAN LEGION POST 18 SCHOLARSHIP

- Be an honorably discharged veteran, or
- Be the spouse of an honorably discharged veteran, or
- Be the child or dependent of an honorably discharged veteran
- Have a minimum high school GPA of 2.5

### Anderson Pontiac, GMC, Olds Baseball Scholarship

- Be selected by the SGC Athletic Director to play on the Tiger baseball team.
- Have a minimum high school GPA of 2.5
- Submit letters of recommendation from high school principal and coach
- Preference will be given to student athletes from Coffee County

- Enter into an agreement to work for one year at Coffee Regional Medical Center for each year on the scholarship

- Be a graduate of Coffee High School
- Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0

- must have a minimum GPA of 2.5

- Must demonstrate financial need
- Funds may be used for any school related expenses such as tuition, housing, or textbooks

- Be enrolled as a full-time non-traditional student in a degree program
- Complete a brief essay on why they should receive the award. This essay must be submitted with the application for a Foundation Scholarship

- Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0

### GRACE JAMES SCHOLARSHIP

- Be a member of an SGC athletic team
- Have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0
- Maintain a first year GPA of at least 2.5 while at SGC to be eligible for a second year scholarship

### BOB JOHNSON SCHOLARSHIP

- Be a member of the SGC baseball team
- Final selection will be made by the SGC Athletic Director

### LENA HARVEY & REGINAL C. KICKLIGHTER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

- Ranked in the top 25 percent of his/her high school class
- Demonstrate significant leadership activity in school and community
- Applicants who are descendants of William Basil Kicklighter of Mendes, or Samuel Alfred Harvey of Glennville, and who meet the established criteria will receive first preference by the selection committee
- Georgia residents with the surname Harvey, Kicklighter, Thompson or Slater who meet the established criteria will be the next in line for consideration. If the above stipulations are not met, students who are Georgia residents will be considered.

- Preference will be given to the applicant whose application indicates a strong potential for future service to the community.
- Recipient has no convictions for criminal offenses other than misdemeanors.
- Satilla REMC Foundation must approve the recipient.
